The International School of Krakow is searching for a **One to One Assistant Teacher** to work directly with a female secondary student with Down Syndrome/cognitive disability. The position will start between March 23rd and April 27th (depending on when the current employee starts her maternity leave) and end on June 18th. The hours are **12:00-15:30 Monday through Friday**. The assistant teacher will support the student in special classes that are led by another teacher (drama, art, music, etc), and 1:1 help the student perform jobs (copying, cutting, typing, etc) as well as play games with her to increase her social skills and use of language. Materials are all provided, with no planning necessary.

Must have:

- Strong English
- Good attendance record
- Either a university degree or working towards a degree
- Positive attitude toward the inclusion of people with disabilities

Desired:

- Experience working with people with disabilities
- Teaching degree
- Written & spoken fluency in English
